

Certified baitfish means ...

An official AAD certificate accompanies each load of Arkansas certified baitfish. On the certificate, you can find the farm name, the species, the size and weight of the load, the date the certificate was issued and when it will expire. The certificate is tamper-evident.



These farm-raised fish are certified free from:

- Spring Viremia of Carp (SVCV)
- Infectious Pancreatic Necrosis (IPNV)
- Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia (VHSV)
- Infectious Hematopoietic Necrosis (IHNV)
- Eurasian watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*)
- Giant salvinia (*Salvinia molesta*)
- Hydrilla (*Hydrilla verticillata*)
- Zebra mussel (*Dreissena polymorpha*)
- New Zealand mud snails (*Potamopyrgus antipodarum*)
- Red-rimmed melania (*Melanoides tuberculata*)
- Sticklebacks (Family Gasterosteidae)
- Rudd (*Scardinius erythrophthalmus*)
- Orfe (*Leuciscus idus*)
- Silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys molitrix*)
- Bighead carp (*Hypophthalmichthys nobilis*)
